LEAD WITH HONESTY

Don't try to paint an unrealistic rosy picture – people know we are living in uncertain times.

LEAD WITH AUTHORITY

God put you in a position of leadership. Show confidence. Recall your unique experience and skill set to get through this crisis.

LEAD WITH COMPASSION

As a PRC leader, you understand what it means to walk in someone else's shoes. You have the heart of a servant, and a love for those in greatest need. Compassion is more important now than ever, as you are serving not just abortion-vulnerable women but the entire community who needs your center for various reasons.

LEAD WITH HUMILITY

No one knows it all. A true leader can say "I don't know the answer, but I will find out and get back to you."

LEAD WITH YOUR TEAM OF EXPERTS

Don't try to do this alone. Great leaders look to their team to provide foundational support for good times and bad times.
